- **Bring Medicines in their original package or container**
- **Deposit the bottle/package into the bin**

- **The drop box is located in the public lobby at the Wadena County Sheriff's Office and is available 24/7/365.**
- **Press the call button inside the first door and you will be let in.**

ACCEPTED:

Household Medications including:

- Prescription Medicines, including controlled substances
- Over-the-Counter Medicines
- Vitamins and Supplements
- Pet Medicines

NOT ACCEPTED:

- Needles, Sharps, Syringes
Sharps can be disposed of at Astera Health
- Medicine from Businesses that Include:
 - Health Care Facilities
 - Pharmacies, Medical Clinics, Doctors' Offices
 - Pharmaceutical Representatives
 - Veterinary Clinics

Help prevent:

- Prescription Drug Misuse
- Accidental Poisonings
- Unsafe disposal in drains and trash which can cause groundwater contamination and pollute water and harm wildlife

The medication drop box is a collaborative effort between the Wadena County Sheriff's Office, Wadena County Public Health, and the Wadena County Opioid Settlement Committee. Opioid settlement dollars have assisted with funding this project from 2024 on.
